IMPORTANT ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE

Construction for the Collingwood Downtown Revitalization project is set to start again on April 5th, 2010. The 1st and 3rd Blocks of Hurontario Street will be closed on April 5th, 2010 and remain closed to vehicular traffic until further notice (approximately June 4, 2010).

Pedestrian and delivery vehicle access will be maintained to all businesses and residences during the construction. Please contact Murray Hunt, Project Supervisor (Construction) (705-443-4277 or mhunt@walkerind.com) so that he is aware of upcoming deliveries. The Contractor shall collect all garbage and recycling containers for pickup by the Town. Please set your containers in front of your business/residence by 6:30 a.m. on your regular garbage day. Clearly label your containers with your business name, address, etc. so that the containers can be returned to you.

Collingwood Downtown Revitalization Project Details:

The Town of Collingwood has entered into a contract with Georgian Paving & Construction for the streetscaping improvements of Downtown Collingwood. The work generally consists of streetscaping improvements along Hurontario Street from First Street to Fourth Street and along Second/Simcoe Street from Pine Street to St. Paul Street.

The overall work will include the relocation of curbs, catch basins and hydrants, installation of new traffic lights at two intersections, new street lighting, partial depth removal of asphalt and reinstatement, new trees, new planters, new irrigation systems, additional electrical and acoustical duct work, new paving stone and concrete sidewalk construction.

Current Construction Events

(March 29th to April 2nd 2010)

1. **Location:** Hurontario St. from First to Second/Simcoe St.
Scope of Work: Surveying and preparatory work prior to starting construction.
Impacts: Minor traffic disruptions during survey work. No anticipated impact on pedestrian access.

2. **Location:** Hurontario St. from Third/Ontario St. to Fourth St.
Scope of Work: Surveying and preparatory work prior to starting construction.
Impacts: Minor traffic disruptions during survey work. No anticipated impact on pedestrian access.

Upcoming Construction Events

(April 5th to April 9th 2010)

1. **Location:** Hurontario St. from First to Second/Simcoe St.
Scope of Work: Install safety fencing 2.0m from the building face to provide pedestrian access to businesses and to provide a safe work area for the Contractor. A mid block street crossing will be provided. The removal of curbs, paving stones, trees and asphalt will commence.
Impacts: This block of Hurontario Street shall remain closed to vehicular traffic until work in this block is complete (approx. first week of June 2010).

2. **Location:** Hurontario St. from Third/Ontario St. to Fourth St.
Scope of Work: Install safety fencing 2.0m from the building face to provide pedestrian access to businesses and to provide a safe work area for the Contractor. A mid block street crossing will be provided. The removal of curbs, paving stones, trees and asphalt will commence.
Impacts: This block of Hurontario Street shall remain closed to vehicular traffic until work in this block is complete (approx. first week of June 2010).

Access rear parking lots on the west side of Hurontario Street within this block shall be provided from Third Street. Signs will be posted to provide direction.

How Will My Services Be Affected?

Telephone, hydro, water, cable TV, sewer and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.

Once the road is closed to vehicular traffic the Contractor will collect garbage and recycling containers. Please set your containers in front of your business by 6:30 A.M. on your regular garbage days. Please **clearly** label your containers with your address, business name, etc. so that the containers can be returned to you.

Safety

Georgian Paving & Construction is required to conduct the work in a safe manner, including delineation of the work area, etc. with the use of traffic cones, caution tape, construction fencing, etc.

The Contractor is required to leave the site in as safe condition as possible for the week ends, over night and Holidays. However, we ask that you take extra caution during these periods to ensure everyone's safety.

Who Do I Call If I Have a Problem?

The "Project Supervisor" (Construction) will respond to public inquiries related to this project. You may call or email the Project Supervisor at any time.

The Contractor has set up a site office on Hurontario St. that is open Monday to Friday, 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

A 24/7 emergency phone number is also provided below but should only be used in emergency or other critical situations.
