Construction Newsletter #20

Current Construction Events (May 25th to May 28th 2010)

1. **Location:** Hurontario St. from First to Second/Simcoe St.
Scope of Work: Continued minor finishing work
Impacts: This block was open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic.
2. **Location:** Hurontario St. from Third/Ontario St. to Fourth St.
Scope of Work: Placed pavers in boulevards, continued placing sidewalks and curbs.
Impacts: This block remained closed to vehicular traffic. Mid-block crossings were relocated or temporarily closed for short periods. Access to businesses was maintained with some periodic inconvenience.
3. **Location:** Second/Simcoe Street, from St. Paul to Pine street.
Scope of Work: Placed pavers in boulevards, completed concrete crosswalks.
Impacts: No Parking along south side of this street. Traffic was restricted to one lane during short periods of time with road closures as per attached closure plan.

Upcoming Construction Events (May 31st to June 4th 2010)

1. **Location:** Hurontario St. from First to Second/Simcoe St.
Scope of Work: Complete lighting installation and continue minor finishing work.
Impacts: This block will be open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic with some parking restrictions and occasional one-lane traffic during the day.
2. **Location:** Hurontario St. from Second/Simcoe St. to Third/Ontario St.
Scope of Work: Continue concrete work around Town Hall and begin concrete work on the remainder of the block.
Impacts: The area in front of Town Hall will remain open to pedestrians with some minor inconveniences. Road will be open to traffic with some parking restrictions and occasional one-lane traffic during the day.
3. **Location:** Hurontario St. from Third/Ontario St. to Fourth St.
Scope of Work: Continue placing new unit pavers, complete sidewalks and curbs.
Impacts: This block will remain closed to vehicular traffic. Mid-block crossings may be relocated or temporarily closed for short periods. Access to businesses will be maintained with some periodic inconvenience.
4. **Location:** Second/Simcoe Street, from St. Paul to Pine street.
Scope of Work: Minor finishing work only.
Impacts: This block will be open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic.

How Will My Services Be Affected?

Telephone, hydro, water, cable TV, sewer and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.

The Contractor shall continue to collect garbage and recycling containers on those blocks that are closed to vehicular traffic. Please set your containers in front of your business by 6:30 A.M. on your regular garbage days. Please **clearly** label your containers with your address, business name, etc. so that the containers can be returned to you.

Safety

Georgian Paving & Construction is required to conduct the work in a safe manner, including delineation of the work area, etc. with the use of traffic cones, caution tape, construction fencing, etc. To expedite construction activities and to ensure public safety the contractor may temporarily close and/or move mid block crossings. Temporary inconveniences to business access may also result during sidewalk construction.

The Contractor is required to leave the site in a safe condition as possible for the week ends, over night and Holidays. However, we ask that you take extra caution during these periods to ensure everyone's safety.

Who Do I Call If I Have a Problem?

The "Project Supervisor" (Construction) will respond to public inquiries related to this project. You may call or email the Project Supervisor at any time.

The Contractor has set up a site office on Hurontario St. that is open Monday to Friday, 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

A 24/7 emergency phone number is also provided below but should only be used in emergency or other critical situations.
