Construction Newsletter #24

June 25th 2010

Current Construction Events (June 21st to June 25th 2010)

1. **Location:** Hurontario St. from First to Second/ Simcoe St.
Scope of Work: Completed plantings in planter beds.
Impacts: This block was open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic.
2. **Location:** Hurontario St. from Second/Simcoe St. to Third/Ontario St.
Scope of Work: Continued unit paver installation on west side of street and began crosswalk installation for southbound lanes..
Impacts: Southbound traffic was detoured along Pine St. during working hours, with no parking on the west side. Northbound traffic and parking was not affected.
3. **Location:** Hurontario St from Third/Ontario St to Fourth St.
Scope of Work: Continued plantings in planter beds..
Impacts: This block was open to traffic with some parking restrictions during working hours.
4. **Location:** Hurontario St. from Fourth St. to Fifth St.
Scope of Work: Began underground electrical, storm sewer and fire hydrant installations
Impacts: This block was open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic with some lane-shifting of two-way traffic to facilitate work.

Upcoming Construction Events (June 28th to July 4th 2010)

1. **Location:** Hurontario St. from Second/Simcoe St. to Third/Ontario St.
Scope of Work: Continue unit paver installation and complete concrete work on the west side of the block. If weather permits, begin asphalt milling, final asphalt paving, and line painting.
Impacts: This block will be closed to traffic for approximately three days, weather dependent.
2. **Location:** Hurontario St. from Fourth St. to Fifth St.
Scope of Work: Complete underground electrical installations and begin concrete removal.
Impacts: This block will be open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic with some lane-shifting of two-way traffic to facilitate work.
3. **Location:** St. Marie St. from Huron St. to Ontario St.
Scope of Work: Begin sawcutting asphalt and storm sewer installation.
Impacts: This block will be open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Traffic may be periodically reduced to one lane during the day. The intersection of St. Marie St. and Ontario St. will have reduced lane widths.
4. **Location:** Hurontario St. from First St. to Fourth St..
Scope of Work: Minor repair and installation of unit pavers at various locations along the street.
Impacts: This block will be open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic with minor inconveniences to pedestrians.

How Will My Services Be Affected?

Telephone, hydro, water, cable TV, sewer and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.

The Contractor shall continue to collect garbage and recycling containers on those blocks that are closed to vehicular traffic. Please set your containers in front of your business by 6:30 A.M. on your regular garbage days. Please **clearly** label your containers with your address, business name, etc. so that the containers can be returned to you.

Safety

Georgian Paving & Construction is required to conduct the work in a safe manner, including delineation of the work area, etc. with the use of traffic cones, caution tape, construction fencing, etc. To expedite construction activities and to ensure public safety the contractor may temporarily close and/or move mid block crossings. Temporary inconveniences to business access may also result during sidewalk construction.

The Contractor is required to leave the site in as safe condition as possible for the week ends, over night and Holidays. However, we ask that you take extra caution during these periods to ensure everyone's safety.

Who Do I Call If I Have a Problem?

The "Project Supervisor" (Construction) will respond to public inquiries related to this project. You may call or email the Project Supervisor at any time.

The Contractor has set up a site office on Hurontario St. that is open Monday to Friday, 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

A 24/7 emergency phone number is also provided below but should only be used in emergency or other critical situations.
